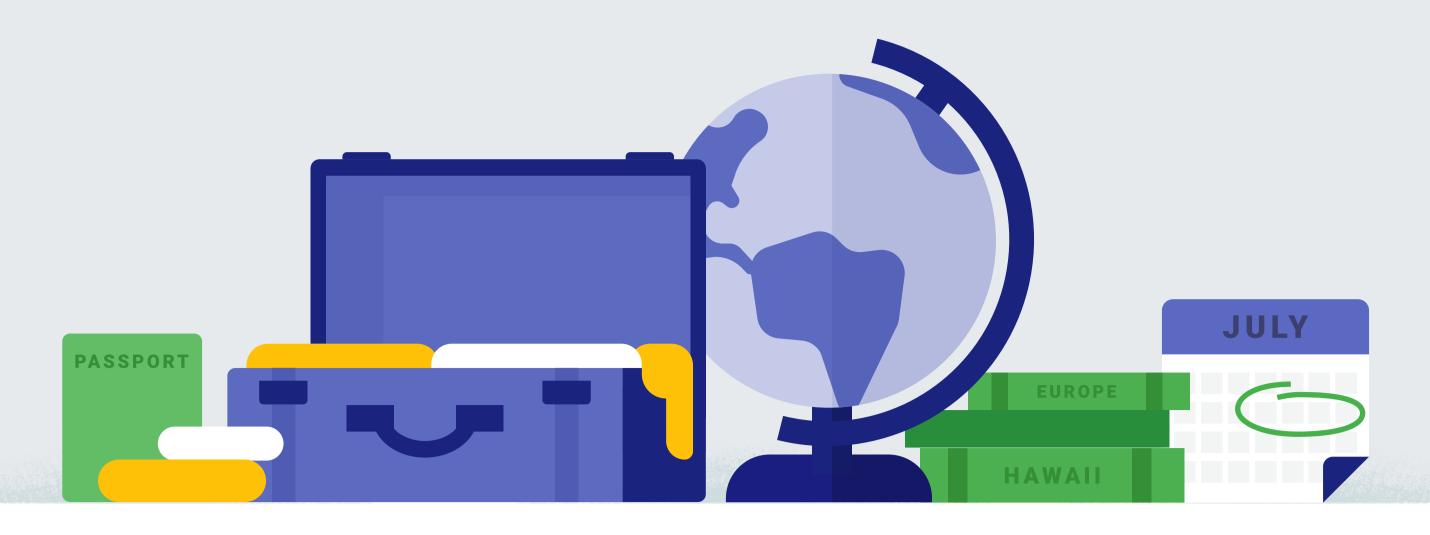
Summer Travel Trends: What Search Activitiy Reveals

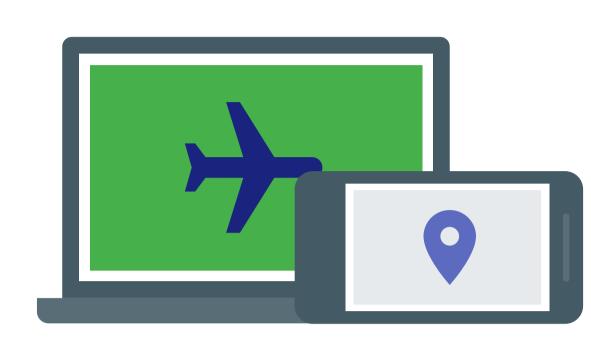
Planning for summer holidays is already in full swing. Six in ten people considering a summer trip were already conducting some type of research in February,1 yet 46% had not decided on their destination.2 Recent searches reveal the types of trips travellers are looking to

On-demand information allows travelers to be spontaneous

Mobile devices enable increased flexibility for travellers. When it comes to planning holiday activities, 16% of those who are researching summer trips will plan most of their activities off the cuff, while they are at their destination.³

Travel categories seeing strong growth have gone mobile. People research more on mobile than on desktop for family holidays, luxury travel and couples travel and honeymoons.⁵

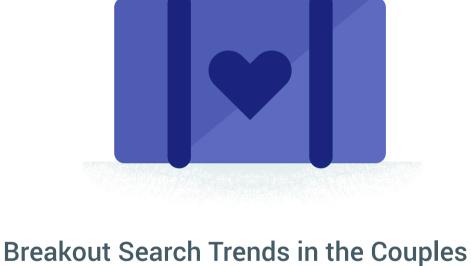

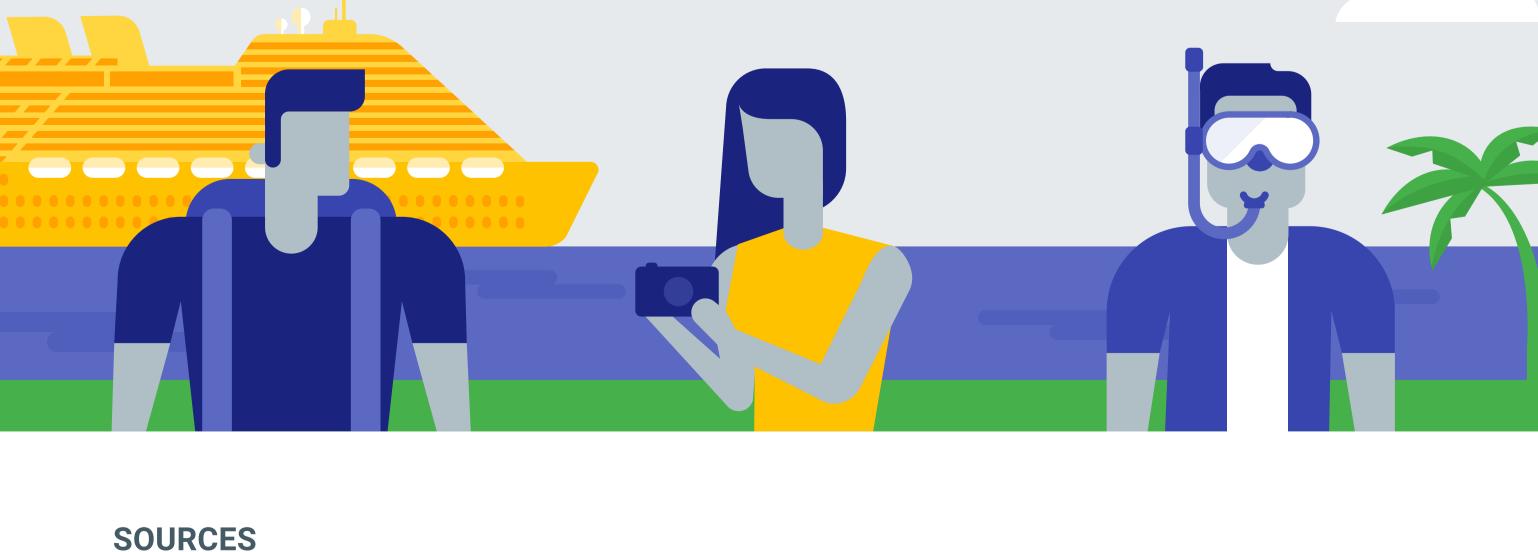
